- 1. The Standard Forest Management Plan:** a summary of typical forest management practices which apply to all FSC forests.
- 2. The FSC Forest Specific Plan:** a specific plan that is unique to a forest/estate.

<b>Management of commercial risk</b>	Market access, infrastructure damage and service disruption
<b>Environmental risk management</b>	Policies, standards and processes, assessment of environmental effects, monitoring, the PF Olsen Environmental Management System
<b>Hazardous substance use</b>	Transport, storage and use and FSC® hazardous chemicals
<b>Crop management</b>	Productivity, establishment and silviculture, species selection, wilding risk management, re-establishment and tree health
<b>Harvesting strategy</b>	Harvest planning, forest infrastructure, contractor management and training
<b>Forest inventory</b>	Pre-assessment, mid-rotation and preharvest inventory, mapping and stand records
<b>Indigenous biodiversity</b>	Riparian setbacks, threatened species, threatened environments, ecosystem management
<b>Cultural and social alignment</b>	Archaeological and historic sites, stakeholder engagement
<b>Property protection</b>	Pest plants and animals, fungal infection and insect control, fire prevention strategies, insurance
<b>Non-timber values</b>	Environmental and social cost benefit analysis, recreational and alternate land uses
<b>Monitoring</b>	Environmental Management System, regulatory compliance, environmental effects
<b>Industry good and research</b>	NZ Forest Owners Association, Forest Growers Levy Trust, industry involvement
